



# Terms and Conditions

- 1** - When a booking is made and agreed on date and time - It is considered Booked & Confirmed. We do call or re-email you 2-3 weeks prior to show date to re-confirm but please consider this as a follow up- the booking has already been made. Any cancellation 2 weeks prior to booking may incur a \$50.00 admin/costs fee.
- 2** - No charge for children under 1's now applies when they are in with another paying group.
- 3** - If a centre is having a multiple of shows, minimum costs are:  
Youngest age (under 2's) \$145.00, Med age (under 3-1/2) \$225.00, Oldest group \$275.00.
- 4** - When agreeing on a set price for a show (not Christmas) the numbers should not significantly exceed the following approximate numbers - Youngest group = 30 children, Mid group = 40 children, Oldest group = 45 children, otherwise another show will be needed and paid for.
- 5** - Payments later than 3 weeks from the Invoice date will incur a \$30.00 admin fee. A \$10.00 admin fee will be added to each following week of non-payment after the 3 week period (unless agreed upon at time of booking).

## **Christmas Shows:**

- 1** - All Christmas Invoices will be sent early November onwards and payments must be made either prior to the show day or within Max 7 days after. All Christmas payments must be made before December 25th or they will incur a \$50.00 admin fee.
- 2** - If a Christmas Character must wait to start through no fault of Showtime Stars, you will be charged at the going rate, or their allotted time will start & finish as booked, OR you agree to pay the extra and the going rate. Christmas Character Prices (per character):  
30 mins = \$150.00, 45 mins = \$225.00, 60 mins = \$300.00.  
If you are planning for the Characters to hand out gifts, you will need to book a minimum of 45 mins, due to extra time needed to do so.

*Please note that the performers are entertainers and are not child minders or crowd controllers. Please help our performers to give the best show possible for your centre, by controlling and attending to children's behaviour.*
